On the 20th March we have many riders participating in the C-Certificate. It has many elements and you must sit a written exam as well as pass ridden requirements. The afternoon will be designated to C-Certificate theory and I would like everyone who is participating to bring their books to the shed at the beginning of the 3rd session. I would like to wish all those riders who are sitting for their C-Certificate the best of luck.

Certificates at pony club are put in place so that you can develop your sense of horsemanship and knowledge of your horse's needs. Pony club is not all about riding. It is also about teaching you how to look after and care for your horse. I am still learning new things and our instructors are a wonderful source of knowledge. If you have any questions please feel free to ask. If you have any ideas of who you may like to hear from ie a guest speaker at Pony Club, please let me know.

Last Rally saw many new members join and I have had some positive feedback from these riders. This rally Alan Mitchell will be taking a Show jumping clinic with designated groups. If you have the opportunity to watch Alan instruct I would strongly recommend it. He is an amazing man who has the memory of an elephant and never forgets a name! He establishes relationships with children he is instructing very quickly and really builds confidence to jump.
