I have had quite a few queries regarding attendance cards. You must have your attendance card at each rally. If you are not competing between rallies your card remains at Pony club. However, if you are competing then you must take your card at the end of the rally and return it before gear check at the following rally. Your card is a record of the rallies you have attended and the level at which you are riding. It also lists your pony club mount. All these points are checked when you compete at an event. Please make sure your card is up to date and that I have signed it. For example:

- You cannot enter an ODE in Grade 4 if I have not signed you off on grade 4 in your book.

- You cannot compete if you do not have your book

If you need to be graded please let me know before the rally.

I am heartened to see our club growing and we have new members beginning again at the February rally. Please make them feel welcome.
